3. No Public comments:
4. Commissioner Wiens moved to approve the real estate abatement in the amount of \$666.94 and the adds for \$877.28 The motion carried unanimously following a second by Commissioner McCloud.
5. Commissioner McCloud moved to approve the updates Road Right of Way Permit with the new fee structure. The motion carried unanimously following a second by Commissioner Wiens.
6. Rice County Public Works Administrator Tom Robl was in to discuss The HRRR Grant for the south east quarter of the county. All the "NO THRU TRUCK" signs will be replaced hopefully by June of 2021.
7. Rice County Public Works Administrator Tom Robl also stated that chemical sale hours are Monday's and Thursday's 1-4.
8. Rice County Attorney Remington Dalke came to let everyone know that court is starting to get busier. He has had an intern shadowing him right now and this has caused things to move a bit slower.

She also stated that she has found someone to help her learn the ropes. The Commissioners told her to go ahead with the purchase of a new laptop from Best Buy and will be reimbursed by CKRPHEP-Central Kansas Regional Public Health Emergency Preparedness? Pam also asked if she could carry over any vacation hours, she had over 40 at the end of July.

15. Commissioner McCloud moved to authorize Rice County Appraiser Gayla Godfrey to purchase a new printer from Bolen Office Supply not to exceed \$640.00. The motion carried unanimously following a second by Commissioner Wiens.
16. Rice County Appraiser Gayla Godfrey presented her letter of resignation to the Commissioner's effective September 30, 2020.
17. Commissioner McCloud moved to authorize Rice County Communications Director Josh Michaelis to purchase computers from Gilmore Solutions not to exceed \$3,425.37 The motion carried unanimously following a second by Commissioner Wiens.
